APPEALS PROCESS

Any person seeking to appeal the decision must submit, in writing, a request to review the decision. This appear must be delivered to the ffice of Institutional Diversity, Equity and Access thin five (5) working days of receipt of the decision. The request shall state reasons why the party is requesting a review and may contain an information for consideration. The appeal will be referred to the Affirmative Action Subcommittee on Disabilities. The committee may confirm, amend, or modify the decision. The decision of the committee shall be final.

MISUSE OF ACCESSIBLE PARKING PERMITS

Persons initially applying for or renewing a permit that knowingly submit false documentation or misuse a State Disabled Parking Placard or a Unisity issued Accessible Parking permit will be subject to a fine and could face the possibility of losing all University Parking Privileges.

Obtaining a parking permit under MSU's parking regulations for individuals with disabilities does not entitle the permit holder to violate any other parking and/or traffic regulations. This includes, but is not limited to, parking in fire lanes, loading zones, or parking in a space reserved for other use. Vehiceds:parklation of MSU's regulations are subject to citation. Further, the use of an accessible parking permit by someone other than the person listed on the Vehicle Registration Form and Application for an Accessible parking Permit may result in a citation, and/or termination of the permit privileges.
