WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GET THIS VACCINE

WHAT IS COVID -19?

COVID-19 is caused by coronavirus called SARSoV-2. This type of coronavirus has not been seen before. You can get COVID through contact with another person who has the virus. It is predominantly a respiratory illness that can affect other organs. People with COVID 19 havehad a wide range of symptoms reported, ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2 to 14 days after exposure to the virus. Symptoms may include: fever or chills; cough; shortness of breath; fatigue; muscle or body aches; headarchess of taste or smell; sore throat; congestion or runny nose; nausea or vomiting; diarrhea.

WHAT IS THE MODERNA COVID -19 VACCINE?

The Moderna COVID19 Vaccine is an approved accine that may prevent COVID-19. There is no FDA approved vaccine to prent COVID-19.

The FDA has authorized emergency use the Moderna COVID19 Vaccine to prevent COVID-19 in individuals 18 years of age and older under an Emergency Use Authorization (EUA).

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WHAT SHOULD YOU MENTION TO YOUR VACCINATION PROVIDER BEFORE YOU GET THE MODERNA COVID -19 VACCINE?

Tell your vaccination provider about all **x**our medical conditions, including if you:

have any allergies

have a fever

have a bleeding disorder or are on a blood thinner are immunocompromised or are on a medicine that affects your immune system are pregnant or plan to become pregnant are breastfeedg

have received another COVID9 vaccine

WHO SHOULD GET THE MODERNA COVID -19 VACCINE?

FDA has authorized the emergency use of the Moderna COGIDaccine in individuals 18 years of age and older.

WHO SHOULD NOT GET THE MODERNA COVID -19 VACCINE?

You should not get the Moderna COVID Vaccine if you:

had a severe allergic reaction after previous dose of this vaccine had a severe allergic reaction to any ingredient of this vaccine

WHAT ARE THE INGREDIENTS IN THE MODERNA COVID -19 VACCINE? The Moderna COVID19 Vaccine containts following ingredients messenger ribonucleic acid (mRNA), lipids (SM-102, polyethylene glycol [PEG2000dimyristoyl glycerol [DMG], cholesterol, and 1, @istearoylsn-glycero-3-phosphocholine [DSPC]) romethamine, tromethamine hydrochloride, acetic acid, sodium acetate, and sucrose.

HOW IS THE MODERNA COVID-19 VACCINE GIVEN?

The Moderna COVID19 Vaccine will be given to you as an injection into the muscle

The Moderna COVID19 Vaccine vaccinationeries 2 dosesgiven 1 month apart

If you receive one dose of the Moderna COVID Vaccine, you should receive a second dose of the same vaccine 1 month later to complete the vaccination series.

HAS THE MODERNA COVID -19 VACCINE BEEN USED BEFORE?

The Moderna COVID19 Vaccine is an approved vaccine. In clinical trials, approximately 15,400 individuals 18 years of age and olderave received at least 1 dose of the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine.
